EXPOSURE VISIT

All our schools are visiting at least one industrial visit related to the program per semester. One such visit for MBA students were taken for outbound training to Sky Academy Coimbatore to learn about leadership skills for a week.

The varsity has innumerable clubs consisting of 25 skill enhancement clubs coding club, startup club, Research club, Google club, sports club, cultural club, Yoga and fitness club, Dance club, music club etc. NSS and Rotaract clubs organized several activities throughout the year.
